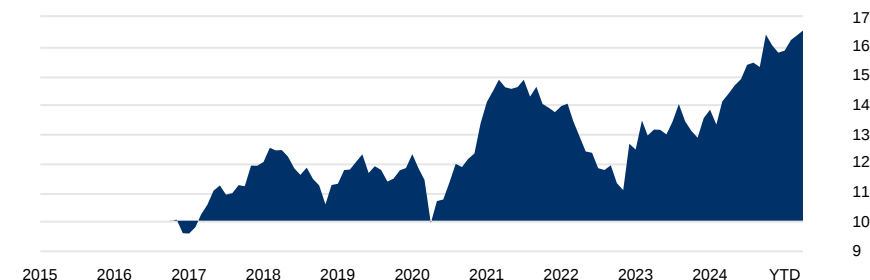

100% MSCI Emerging Markets Total Return Net Index (CAD)

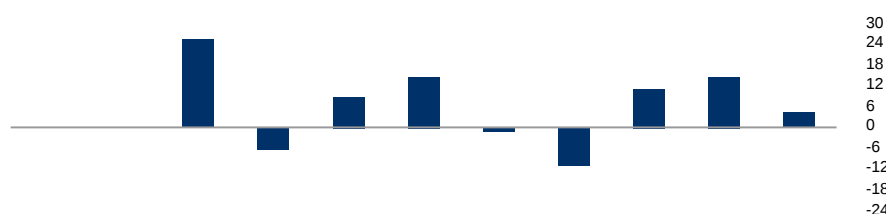
