Detailed credit and industry analysis is conducted to evaluate opportunities for superior rates of return while simultaneously minimizing default prospects. The portfolio is well-diversified across issuer, industry and credit rating, with the goal of balancing volatility with portfolio return optimization. Mandate guidelines are flexible, with the option to tilt toward investment-grade bonds when appropriate.

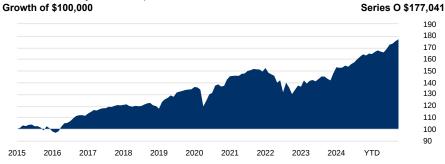

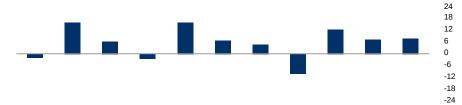
